





#### 2. Plein Air to Studio Workshop with Thomas Jefferson Kitts





Spend 3 days learning new plein air techniques and painting the beautiful views around The Woodlands Texas in the springtime. Then spend the next 2 days with Thomas in the Woodlands Art League studio developing your plein air paintings into a finished studio work.

The workshop starts on Monday, June the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 at 9:00 am and ends on Friday, June the 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 4:30 pm.




Intermediate and advanced students will work on more challenging drawing and painting projects that may include drawing from reference photos and still life.

#### Classes

#### 2.Beginner/Intermediate Pastel Class with Tetyana Aleksenko



Thursdays, on April 18 and April 25, 2024, from 10 am till 12 pm at WAL location.

In this class you will learn how to paint with soft pastels without having to purchase expensive materials and supplies. This class is suitable for beginners and intermediate level students. We will start with simple sketches to learn how to apply pastels and progress to more complex paintings.

Each student will be provided with pastel paper and a limited palette of hard and soft pastels during class. You are welcome to bring your own supplies that you are comfortable working with. We will work on some projects together and on individual projects of your choice.

Cost is \$80 for 2 (two) 2-hour classes for members or \$100 for non-members paid on a monthly basis. If you miss a class for any reason, please request a make-up lesson, no refunds. Upcoming dates: Wednesdays, March 27, April 10, April 24, and May 3 2024, from 10 am to 12:30 pm at WAL location.


